### Dr. Tom Elliott: Expert Medicolegal Witness

Dr. Elliott has been providing expert medical opinions for more than twelve years in the context of civil lawsuits, applications, and criminal matters. He has provided timely, impartial and valuable advice to the Vancouver Police Department, the British Columbia Attorney General, the Insurance Corporation of British Columbia (ICBC), the Canadian Medical Protective Association (CMPA), as well as scores of lawyers conducting personal injury litigation for both plaintiffs and defendants.
